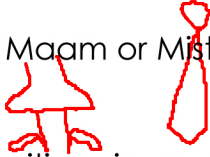


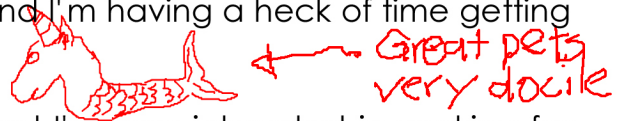
# ANDREW BAGLEY
